<b>Present System</b> Tenses in the <i>present</i> system are formed from the <b>present stem</b> (found in the second principal part of the verb) The <i>present</i> tense <i>stem</i> is found by dropping the <b>-re</b> from the end of the <b>second</b> principal part (also known as the infinitive form).	<b>Perfect System</b> Tenses in the <i>perfect</i> system are formed from the <b>perfect stem</b> (found in the third principal part of the verb) The <i>perfect</i> tense <i>stem</i> is found by dropping the <b>T</b> from the end of the <b>third</b> principal part (also known as the perfect form)
